Introduction

Some 2015 model year Prius V vehicles may exhibit an intermittently inoperative radio/navigation touch screen after the vehicle has hot or cold soaked. The only way the touch controls are able to be recovered is to cycle the ignition or reboot the head unit. Follow the procedures in this bulletin to address this condition.

Warranty Information (Continued)

APPLICABLE WARRANTY

- This repair is covered under the Toyota Basic Warranty. This warranty is in effect for 36 months or 36,000 miles, whichever occurs first, from the vehicle's in-service date.
- Warranty application is limited to occurrence of the specified condition described in this bulletin.

Repair Procedure

1. Confirm the condition as described in the Introduction.

A. If the vehicle interior is warm:

Start the vehicle and set the A/C to MAX LO Recirculate, then when the interior temperature has reached ambient temperature, confirm the condition.

B. If the vehicle interior is cold:

Start the vehicle and set the HVAC to MAX HI Recirculate, then when the interior temperature has reached ambient temperature, confirm the condition.

- 2. Could the condition described in the Introduction be duplicated?
 - YES Continue to step 3.
 - NO This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.
- 3. Replace the head unit with a remanufactured head unit.

- 4. Confirm condition is no longer present.
